1. Registration fee - (NON-refundable) \$100.00
2. Supply or book fees - (NON-refundable upon acceptance)
 - \$125.00 Program A&B \$150.00 Program C supply fee
 - \$275.00 K-8 book fee

Acceptance Process:

Children must be age appropriate for all programs and grades.

3 by August 31st for 2 day program

5 by August 31st for Kindergarten

6 by August 31st for Grade 1

Order of acceptance is as follows:

1. ~Siblings of children already present in St. Mary School
2. ~Children of teachers working at St. Mary School
3. ~Children of registered, active, and contributing members of St. Mary Parish
4. ~Children transferring from other Catholic Schools
5. ~Children of registered and contributing members of other Catholic parishes
6. ~Other families interested in Catholic education

The Pastor and Principal make all final acceptance decisions.
